PURPOSE:

The Society is established to recognize those members and friends of The Foundation for the History of Women in Medicine who have named the Foundation a beneficiary of their estate through their wills, trusts, or other planned giving vehicles.

REQUIREMENTS:

The donor will be recognized during their lifetime when the Foundation is notified of their commitment of a gift of any size by any one of the following means:

1. Signing of a "letter of Intent"
2. Signing of an Endowment Agreement for gifts of \$25,000 or more.
3. Signing of a Bequest Pledge which makes the gift irrevocable.
4. Establishment of a Charitable Remainder Trust or other agreement.

Gifts of less than \$25,000 will be designated for the general endowment of the Foundation. Gifts of \$25,000 or more may be specified as a named endowment.

RECOGNITION:

Donors will be recognized in Foundation publications and at the Annual Alma Dea Morani Award Presentation.

PROCESS:

Donor will receive a thank you from the president with a "letter of intent", Endowment Agreement or Bequest Pledge to sign in triplicate. One copy remains on file with the Foundation, two copies returned to donor for personal file and attorney.
